Mataraki Shared Meal and Quiz

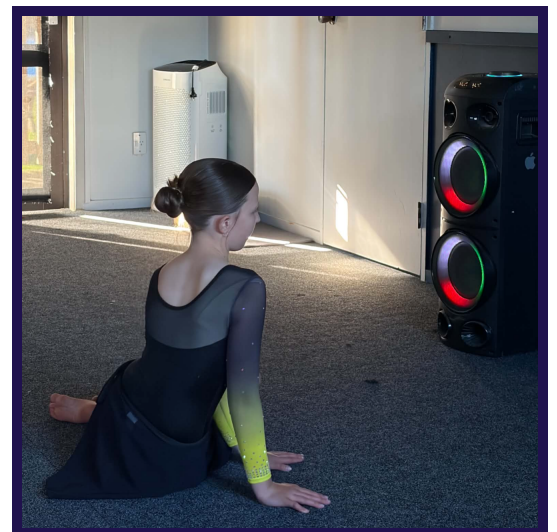
